

Joseph Verrochi, Aged 87, Founded Marinucci Firm

A high requiem Mass will be sung for Joseph Verrochi, 87, founder of the Marinucci Construction Corporation, at 8:30 a.m., Saturday in St. Agatha's Church, Milton. He died Tuesday.
